10 KEY POINTS/THEMES FOR AFRICAN SOCIAL WORK

- 1. ISSUES OF FOOD SECURITY & NUTRITION and equity should be top on social workers' agenda, feminisation of poverty, gender pay gap, gender injustice
- Issues of DECOLONISATION and representation are historical but should remain top on the agenda for African social work, Action is what is lacking
- 3. We can address these issues in UNITY, through our associations like ASWnet, ASSWA, AU, IASSW, AU etc
- 4. LEADERSHIP: its time for Africa to lead not to follow, to have a strong voice to address African issues
- 5. Up the social action field of social work to address the **structural** issues that affect the masses in Africa. We need to go beyond 'counselling the hungry and poor'
- 6. Remedial social work still a big issue: students just want to counsel, developmental SW neglected still
- 7. Embracing the positive benefits of **technology**, esp to Pwds and women in the informal sector using digital technologies and social media
- 8. Women's contribution in the informal economy need to be recognised as survival for most women-we build on this strength in their empowerment
- 9. Field work training still neglected area in social work education
- 10. Field placement models that match developmental social work that addresses structural issues e.g. workshop, floating, village camping, group block, etc field placement
